- TASTING NOTES -

Complex aromas of ripe raspberry, thimbleberry and liquorice join spicy notes of white pepper and cinnamon. Full-bodied with delicate tannins provide an elegant and long finish.

WINEMAKING

Kenwood has prided itself on its highly acclaimed, consistent gold medal winning Sonoma Zinfandel since its first vintage in 1970. The intense spicy and fruity notes make it a perennial favorite with our winemakers.

The majority of vineyards used to produce the 2013 vintage are located in the Sonoma Valley and Dry Creek Valley, both known for crafting superior Zinfandel.

Like the prior vintage, the 2013 growing was dry and temperate with excellent weather for producing superior wine grapes. Harvest began last September when the individual vineyards reached their peak of flavor. Each vineyard lot was fermented and aged separately in 75% French and 25% American oak barrels for 20 months.

After aging, the wines were blended for taste and balance and just prior to bottling a small amount of Syrah was added to bring additional complexity and backbone.
